The Gatsby Benchmarks

The Gatsby Benchmarks, developed by the Gatsby Charitable Foundation, provide clear guidelines for schools and colleges in England to deliver outstanding careers education. These benchmarks cover eight essential areas:

1. A Stable Careers Programme:

• We establish a consistent, well-defined careers programme that is integrated into the school curriculum and accessible to all students.

2. Learning from Career and Local Labour Market Information:

• We provide students with up-to-date labour market information and career resources. This helps them understand various career opportunities and the skills required to succeed in the world of work.

3. Addressing the Needs of Each Pupil:

• We tailor career guidance to meet the individual needs of every student, ensuring that all students receive the appropriate support to explore and achieve their career or future pathway goals.

4. Linking Curriculum Learning to Careers:

• We connect classroom learning to future careers, showing students how their education applies to real-world jobs and industries.

5. Encounters with Employers and Employees:

 We facilitate meaningful interactions with professionals through career fairs, workplace visits, and guest speakers, giving students insights into various professions.

6. Experiences of Workplaces:

• We offer students practical work experience and/or workplace visit opportunities, helping them gain first-hand knowledge of different work environments.

7. Encounters with Further and Higher Education:

• We provide guidance on post-16 and post-19 educational options, ensuring students are aware of the pathways available to them after Five Acre Wood.

8. Personal Guidance:

• We ensure that each student has access to personalised career guidance where appropriate, helping them make informed decisions about their future.

Personalising the curriculum involves understanding a student's abilities, interests, and needs, and adapting our guidance accordingly.
