

Adepitan class has 14 pupils, whose ages range from 12-14 years. They are supported by a Class Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and 3 Teaching Assistants. Adepitan class is within the Practical learning approach.

The primary focus of our learning is to promote independence throughout the pupils' education, to ensure that they have the necessary skills to be as independent as possible.

The Practical learning approach work closely with all pupils to ensure they improve their resilience, communication, confidence and to provide them real life experiences. They also practice living skills, literacy, numeracy, topic, Attention Autism, phonics, reading, art and sensory circuits.

Pupils have the chance to experience an array of opportunities that are given to us at school, by visiting the community on a regular basis, weekly horticulture, cooking lessons and looking after the many animals we have on site, including goats, chickens, rabbits and pigs.
