



Adlington class is within the Practical learning approach. There are 12 pupils in class, with 4 members of staff to support them.

Pupils are working on their independence and life skills, alongside normal class based skills. We ensure that there are regular opportunities for our pupils to learn outside the classroom. We access the community regularly, including shopping trips to local supermarkets. We learn about gardening, animal care and forestry skills in our woodland workshop. Our pupils cook themselves a 3 course meal on a weekly basis. These activities help to develop the skills and knowledge that our pupils will need as they progress through their teenage years and towards their independent adult life.
