

Boone class is a 6th form class based at our Snodland site and is within the Functional learning approach. There are 7 pupils in the class with ages ranging from 16-18 years. There are 4 members of staff dedicated to increasing pupils' resilience, independence and wellbeing through learning life skills. This is to enable them to gain confidence when moving on and transitioning to their next pathway, post 19.

Throughout the year, we will be engaging in activities that encourage pupils' participation in off-site learning in work-based environments such as Communigrow, our allotment, visiting the local community to do shopping for their cooking lesson, using local public transport and accessing the local leisure centre for swimming lessons.

Pupils run mini enterprises, such as supplying a local café with sweet cones that they have made which are then sold for a profit. They also wash staff cars in the car park. Such enterprises enable pupils to appreciate the benefits of their efforts when they are able to spend the profit they have made on end of year treats.

We are developing a Secret Garden project. This has evolved from an overgrown patch of land that we have cut back and our aim is to develop a sensory garden that will benefit our pupils, helping to provide a calm environment throughout the year.
