



Gershwin class is within the Structured learning approach. There are 10 pupils aged between 11-13 years, who are supported by 4 members of staff.

We enjoy lots of sensory and outdoor activities including water play, food exploration and making our own sensory equipment. Gershwin class follow the TEACCH approach during learning rotations which consists of 1:1 sessions, workstation tasks to promote independence, group work to aid social skills and communication development and leisure activities for self-regulation.

We enjoy a mixture of activities including reading stories together as a group, learning how to write independently, using objects to count and creating our own artwork. As a secondary Structured class we follow a project based curriculum and each term we have a specific topic focus, which is integrated into all aspects of our learning and encourages parental/carer input and whole school connectedness, such as with our art gallery and coffee mornings.
