

Haydn class has 11 pupils ranging in age from age 8-10 years. There are 3 members of staff in class; a Class Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and a Teaching Assistant. Haydn class is within the Structured learning approach and caters to each pupil's individual needs.

Pupils learn through using the TEACCH approach, where they complete 1:1, group and independent activities with a leisure period in between each area of work. Pupils use lots of visuals to support them in class, including individual schedules which tell them what they are doing throughout the day, communication boards and choosing boards. Pupils will be engaging in activities that specifically focus on their EHCP targets, as well as focusing on their personal, social and emotional development.

Pupils enjoy lots of sensory and messy play in Haydn class. They also enjoy being outside in the sensory garden and visiting the farm. They love cooking and enjoy being able to be independent in using the equipment, which helps them to develop their life skills.
