

Liszt are a class of upper primary and secondary pupils ranging from year 5 to year 8. Liszt class are within the Structured learning approach. Pupils make their needs known using speech, signs or symbols. In class there is a Class Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant, a Teaching Assistant and a cover Teaching Assistant.

Pupils love exploring outside spaces around school such as the sensory garden, the field and the MUGA. They enjoy taking part in structured group work, one to one and independent activities and are working on turn taking, communication and shared attention skills.

This year, pupils will learn about these topics; 'All about me', 'Home and community safety', 'Meal preparation and cooking', 'Independent living', 'Social skills' and 'Travel safety'. Every day, sessions will include opportunities to work on emotional regulation, structure and routines, independence skills and individual targets.
