In Monet class, we have lots of fun using our senses to explore the world around us and we are learning to be more independent with our life skills. We take an individualised approach to learning which allows each pupil to focus on what is most important for them.

Our main focus is on developing our physical abilities and communication skills. We develop our functional mobility through individualised physiotherapy programmes, the MOVE programme and fine motor activities. We build on our communication skills using a variety of Augmentative and Alternative Communication strategies including VOCAs, symbols and photos. We also focus on building our attention and interaction skills through many fun programmes such as; Attention Autism, Tap Tap Box, Sensology, sensory stories and Dance Massage.

We love being outside and pride ourselves on being weather warriors! We enjoy water play in the sun, splashing in muddy puddles in autumn and having snow ball fights in winter. We are looking forward to all the fun this year will bring.
