

Mozart is a class within the Structured learning approach. There are 11 pupils in the class, together with 4 members of staff to support them.

Pupils follow the TEACCH learning theory, focusing on 1:1 development of skills, independent workstation activities, collaborative group work and leisure exploration. They enjoy participating in cooking sessions, where they plan, prepare and eat a variety of meal choices.

Pupils learn through exploration and they help each other to learn through team games and scaffolding of skills. They spend some of their afternoons doing horticulture or accessing the sensory garden and trim trail with their peers.
