In addition to these, they will explore life beyond school through our Preparation for Adulthood classes. These classes offer opportunities to visit the farm at the Loose site, engage in cooking activities, explore potential careers and develop essential life skills to support them in the future. The pupils are also working diligently towards achieving their City & Guilds Functional Skills qualifications in English and Maths.

Sport is a particular passion for all the pupils in Shakespeare class, with football being a firm favourite. They also enthusiastically take part in our morning gym sessions, keeping them both active and motivated.
