

Thula class consists of 12 pupils and 4 members of staff who support pupils with their engagement and learning.

Throughout the academic year, we will be focussing on building positive relationships with both staff and their peers, learning about regulating our emotions, developing both verbal and non-verbal communication skills and increasing our independence. This will be done through a variety of activities within the classroom and our own garden, but also by providing pupils opportunities to explore other areas within the school grounds, such as Forest School, the sensory garden, MUGA, soft play and the field.

Within Early Years, we follow the Curiosity Approach and the 'hygge' ethos. This involves us focussing on establishing calm and homely learning environments and providing ample opportunities for open-ended and natural learning activities to ensure pupils feel comfortable and safe whilst at school to enable them to fully explore their own ideas and creativity.
