



Zimmer class is a key stage 1 and 2 class with 9 pupils who are supported by a Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and 2 Teaching Assistants. Zimmer class is within the Structured learning approach and pupils use TEACCH and SCERTs to support with learning.

Zimmer class pupils enjoy messy play, structured activities and being outside where we can complete sensory circuits to prepare us for learning. Zimmer class are continuing to learn how to communicate through individually personalised visuals. All pupils are working on personalised targets from their Educational Health Care Plan to support with cognition and learning, communication and interaction, social emotional and mental health, physical and sensory and independence.

We have embedded some aspects of Hygge into the learning environment to bring a feeling of 'home from home' , to help pupils to feel safe and warm. We have incorporated aspects of The Curiosity Approach to support pupils to transition from early years and to facilitate some open-ended learning.
