



Grieg class is within the Structured learning approach. In class there are 12 pupils who are supported by a Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and 2 Teaching Assistants. Pupils learn through using the TEACCH approach where they complete 1:1, group and independent activities with a leisure period in between each area of work.

Pupils use lots of visuals to support them in class, including individual schedules which tell them what they are doing throughout the day, communication boards and choosing boards. Pupils engage in activities that specifically focus on their EHCP targets, as well as focusing on their personal, social and emotional development.

Pupils engage in Attention Autism, Sensory Circuits, Write Dance, HandyPac and Dough Disco in small groups. They enjoy going to soft play, the trim trail, the field, the MUGA and forest school. They have lots of fun learning in the outdoor environments.
