

Picasso class are a primary based class within the Sensory learning approach. We currently have 8 Pupils and a 5 members of staff. We work on developing pupil's skills in 5 key areas which are; My Body, My Communication, My Thinking, My Independence and Me and My Community.

Our days comprise of working on bespoke plans for each pupil, encompassing their EHCP targets, physio plans and needs. Afternoons are filled with enrichment and creative learning task within a grouped setting to provide social communication learning opportunities. Pupils enjoy activities such as music and movement, art, cooking and farm meet and greet sessions.

All pupils in the class have access to different opportunities such as accessing the MSI room to meet VI/HI needs as well as Rebound Therapy and hydrotherapy. Pupils access their learning in very different ways and as a class team we promote a whole communication approach for our pupils. The use of touch speech cues, Makaton and object cues ensure each pupil is supported in an individual way.

With outcomes and progression at the core of our focus, our classroom is also a place of fun, happiness and pride.
