

Tolkien class has 13 key stage 4 pupils, who are supported by a Class Teacher, a Senior Teaching Assistant and 3 Teaching Assistants. Tolkien class is within the Secondary Formal learning approach.

Our learning is very 'hands-on' and we have lots of exciting enrichment activities lined up throughout the year. These include; Communigrow, cooking two-course meals, shopping trips to Tesco, Morrisons and the local high street, as well as growing vegetables at the allotment. All these activities help to nurture creativity, curiosity and critical thinking through a life/theme-based curriculum.

In Tolkien Class, pupils work towards their ASDAN Life Skills Challenge Award, with the 12 required units woven into their curriculum throughout the year. For term one, the themes are 'Internet Safety' and 'Mexico' and pupils will explore these topics in engaging, creative and fun ways.
